

Library Materials & Resources

The library houses 23,411 books, encyclopedias, and other materials. There are 24 computers for student use which provide access to POWER Library, a collection of online databases, and the Internet. There is also a library research Web page, called a research portal, which has hundreds of links to sites related to classroom topics. Students can also access the *Opposing Viewpoints* database from their home computer through the library research Web portal. A password is required to enter the database. Library & Internet Use Rules

- ◆ Talking must be quiet and kept to a minimum
- ◆ Students may visit the library from study halls a total of two DAYS per week on a white pass. If additional time is needed for research, the student must acquire a pink reference pass from the classroom teacher who assigned the work.
- ◆ Food or beverage bottles are not permitted. Any visible bottles will be confiscated and not returned.
- ◆ Students with over due books or outstanding fines may not check out additional books until the obligation is fulfilled. These students are also not permitted to come to the library from study hall except on a pink reference pass from a classroom teacher.

- ◆ Disrespect of library patrons, materials, and/or staff is not acceptable.
- ◆ The Internet may be used for classroom assignments, research projects, career research, or college investigation. It may NOT be used to check e-mail accounts, visit or participate in forums or chat rooms, playing games online, Web logging (blogging) for any reason outside of class activities, visiting inappropriate sites.

Failure to follow library rules will result in disciplinary action.
